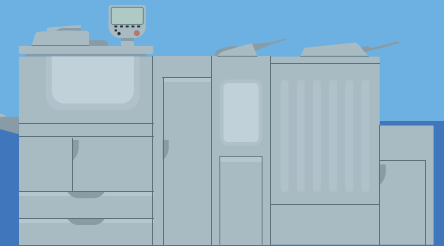

Dear Gaslight-Baker Theatre patrons and supporters:

My colleagues on the Gaslight-Baker Theatre board of directors just reelected me to another term as artistic director. So it looks like you are stuck with me another two years.

Seriously though, I am honored that they trusted me to lead the production of shows at this incredible institution and to help continue its long history of high-quality entertainment and artistic achievement.

Of course I couldn't do any of it without them and our incredible pool of volunteers who act and direct in shows, who build sets and run tech, who design ads and playbills, who man the box office and concession stand, and all the other things that make this place and this organization so great.

I'm also honored to be the artistic director in this particular year of 2020, the year we celebrate the centennial of the Baker Theatre. To more closely coincide with the actual date of the opening of the theater, we have moved our annual gala from April to September, and it will be a long weekend of events and celebrations. Be on the lookout for more announcements on that.

As part of the celebration, we've lined up a roster of big-name shows for our season. We begin with Mary Chase's classic comedy *Harvey* and a new adaptation by Ken Ludwig of Agatha Christie's *Murder on the Orient Express*. In May we will stage a really funny Texas-set farce *Wedding Belles*. *One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest* will run in August, and in October we stage an adaptation of Edgar Lee Master's classic books of poems and vignettes, *Spoon River Anthology*. Finally, in December, we are doing our first musical in eight years, *Godspell*. We'll also be putting on our annual variety shows, *Vaudeville* and the *USO Tribute Show*.

Whew! That's a lot. But there's more: we will continue to show films in between our stage shows (which will always be our number-one focus), host our one-act play contest, and operate our kids' camps in the summer. Our big programming goal for this year is expand our education opportunities to include more regular classes for young people and to begin to offer acting and improv classes for adults.

Thanks for being a part of all the things we do, and thanks for your support as we try new things. We couldn't do it without your continued interest and enthusiasm. Here's to an exciting 2020!
